



### ORDINANCE TEXT FOR VOLUME CONTROL

The text below can be used by local governmental units when revising or creating a storm water ordinance to meet the Chapter 13 requirements. Local governmental units must implement a storm water ordinance consistent with the Rules by January 1, 2003.

All land development activities subject to this Ordinance shall establish on-site management practices to:

- a. Control the runoff leaving the site to a release rate of less than 0.5 cfs/ac for the one (1) percent probability event (100-year recurrence interval) and less than 0.15 cfs/ac for the fifty (50) percent probability event (2-year recurrence interval), or
- b. Control the runoff volume from the site over the critical time period of the watershed. Runoff volume shall be limited to existing conditions for the one and fifty percent probability events according to the District's guidance.
